He fired a short burst and enemy broke off to attack again when our gunner again opened fire only to have the a/a break away. The J.U.88 gained height and attacked from the stbd bow above. Sgt Harme again opened fire at 600 yards and as he passed overhead he noticed smoke issuing from the a/a which kept going straight across the stbd quarter losing height. Our r/g gave another short burst although the enemy a/c was spiralling down to sea. 2 J.U.88's claimed destroyed.
