	2. 11. 44.		Weather - clear and warmer. Operations scheduled. 17 aircraft detailed, with Dusseldorf the target. From this Operation two of our aircraft are missing, Captains being CAN. J. 25738 P/O H. Knobovitch, and CAN. J. 29274 P/O W.H. Reginald. Flying on his last trip of 1st. tour prior to screening, was CAN. J. 38161 W.S. Huskisson, Air Gunner - thus this second major loss to this Squadron doubly accentuated. All initial administration work in regard to missing personnel completed. Official letter received today, advising that due to regulations now in force this Squadron is unable to secure a change of name, suggestion had been forwarded to R.C.A.F. Overseas Headquarters, that the title "Swordfish" be changed to "Bronco". However, "Swordfish" its to be and thus Coastal Command has thus a spiritual share in all our Operations.	
	3. 11. 44.		Weather - rain in morning - clear during remainder of day. CAN. R. 129752 W/O. I. Fry, P.O. an Air Gunner, who has been absent without leave for four days - from open arrest on a previous charge of absent without leave returned. Now in close arrest - awaiting trial by Courts Martial. Not a "W" case - just stupidity.	
	4. 11. 44.		Weather - rain in morning - clear and cool remainder of day. Commissioning interviews for Air Crew personnel now on a speed-up plan - with Station Commander interviewing four and possibly six per day from this Squadron. Backlog should soon disappear. Operations scheduled. Bochum is the target and 16 aircraft detailed. Primary target hit - with good results obtained, and all our aircraft returned safely to Base. Light flak, but no enemy aircraft seen by our laddies.
