"	23.6.42.		2/ P/O. J.H.L. St. Germain reports to R.A.F. Station, DISENFORTH, Yorks to take over as Adjutant of the 425 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron, First French-Canadian Bomber Squadron ever formed in U.K.																
"	26.6.42.		3/Ldr. J.M.W. St. Pierre arrived to take over command. With him reported P/Lt. C.A. Roy and P/Lt. J.L. Seward, both of whom are going to be Flight Commanders. P/O. H. Roberge posted as Squadron Engineer also reported same date. Organisation and clean up work is started immediately with the aid of a few ground crew men who begin to report daily (see strength report below). This Squadron is formed in No. 4 Group. It is a bomber Squadron equipped with Wellingtons Mark III's B.O.B.C. letter Establishment WAB/30/15A dated 1.5.42 and is formed at DISENFORTH - Yorks. This Squadron is non-operational for the time being.
